

Parents,

In accordance with Broward County Child Care Licensing all child care centers must keep a written discipline policy on file for each child.

Minimum standards for child discipline practices to ensure that age-appropriate, constructive disciplinary practices are used for children while at the center.

Such standards shall include at least the following requirements:

I have read and caree to the above discipline policy

- Children shall not be subjected to discipline which is severe, humiliating or frightening.
- Discipline shall not be associated with food, rest or toileting.
- Spanking or any other form of physical punishment is prohibited.

DISIPLINE POLICY:

- 1. Upon first act of inappropriate behavior from child a warning or distraction is given, a second warning may be given.
- 2. If inappropriate behavior continues after warnings are given, a 'time out' is used. This removes the child from the activities of the other children.
- 3. Upon continuance of inappropriate behaviors a second 'time out' is used. This one separating the child to the school office.
- 4. The final action taken is notification by the director to the child's parent about the inappropriate behaviors.
- 5. If repeated inappropriate behaviors continue, a referral will be made for family/school intervention from a third party.
- 6. If referral's are not accepted by the family and/or the behaviors begin to negatively effect other children at the center, the child will be terminated from the program.
