

Welcome to the Montessori Ivy League Academy

We are very happy to have you as part of the Montessori family. This letter, and the following material, has important information regarding our school. We are excited to work together to help our children achieve their full potential. In order to do so, we ask you to please keep in mind our school policies, procedures, and parent responsibilities.

First Day of School: Beginning a new school is very exciting but comes with anxiety and nervousness for some parents and children. We will do our best to ensure a seamless transition and to ensure that each child feels loved, respected, and safe.

Important Notes:

- → Children must be dropped off and picked up in the reception area, so they can independently be escorted to their classrooms and back, respecting our Montessori way (parents are also welcome to walk their kids the first day of the school, and come back after a few minutes, and observe the child from the door window, or the camera TV screen placed in the conference room). Please kindly respect the sanctity of our classrooms, maintain silence, and do not disturb other students working.
- → Jewelry (of any kind) is not allowed due to safety reasons. Please, do not bring toys to the schools; they are very distracting.
- → Please be understanding with items that might get lost. We do our best, but since our focus is our children, things get lost. Please do not send items to school that have a special value to you.
- → For the safety of our children, the staff will only perform administrative duties after 10 AM.
- → Effective communications is important between our teachers and parents. Please always contact your child's teachers, if you have any questions or concerns via our Montessori Compass platform (leaving messages at the front reception desk is not effective). This includes phone conference, in-person conference, or any questions that you may have, for example about snacks, birthdays, etc.

Happy Birthday Celebrations! If your child is having a birthday soon, then please ask for a birthday form at the front desk and submit the completed form at least 4 days in advance, so we can book it for that special day and teachers can prepare a nice celebration.

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Dear Prep parents,

These are the supplies our children need over the period of the school year. We will keep you updated to replenish, if needed.

Dress Code: Children must come in uniform, closed shoes (no sandals or crocs). Each child must bring two sets of clothing to keep in school (shirt, shorts, socks and underwear). We would really appreciate if all <u>clothes are labelled</u>

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Nap Time: Full time students must bring their <u>own twin size fitted sheet</u> and cover every Monday. These items will go home on Fridays for washing.

Please label all items with the child's name with large letters with a sharpie marker.

Snacks: Each week, one child will be assigned to bring a snack, for the whole class, for the *following* week. The list of items will go home on **Thursdays**. Please email us if you have any questions. Please bring the snack items requested on **Mondays**.

Please keep in mind that we serve snacks three times a day.

Lunch: We teach healthy eating, manners, grace, and courtesy.

Each child must bring a healthy well-balanced lunch (no sugary food items, such as gummy bears, cookies, etc...). If it is home lunch, then please bring it in a thermos; we do not warm up food. Sippy cups/bottles (Class #1 only). Also, please ensure that there are no cartoon characters on the lunch boxes or sippy cups etc. Please pack everything in the Montessori School Bag (the one given at the time of registration).

Pull-Ups (weekly): Hygiene is important so that our kids are free of rashes & and other health issues. Please consider this chart (& your daily reports) to bring the pull-ups and wipes (Mondays).

- 20 pull-ups weekly: Part time schedule
- 30 pull-ups weekly: Full time schedule till 3pm
- 40 pull-ups weekly: Full time PLUS after care
